Accountability:

Responsibilities

- Vision Development
 - Moving OBF forward in its vision and mission statement
 - Development of programs and ministries specifically targeted to people who are unreached – with the end of building relationships that lead others to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ as Lord
 - Challenge, recruit, mentor and train people from within OBF to assist with community engagement and involvement to see relationships built up
 - Support the already existing ministries within our fellowship (JR High, SS, other)
 - Collaborate and connect with Community based organizations to help meet specific needs (local schools or neighbourhood groups)
- Pastoral Care:
 - Visitation of all members – for the discovery of needs and discipleship
 - Model and oversee pastoral care
 - Oversee church-life events, including infant dedications, baptisms, weddings and funerals
 - Develop OBF Inner community (healing, care, pastoral support)
 - Development of mentoring opportunities – Discipleship, Small Groups, Programs, Prayer Ministry
- Worship:
 - Creatively engage OBF congregation through the coordination of God’s Word through music, scripture and service
- Preaching:
 - Serve/ lead as part of a preaching team

 - As assigned
